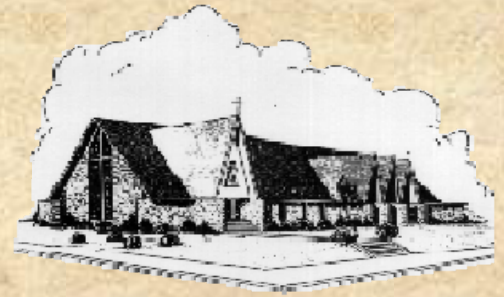

Matthew Bible Study Weekly Q & A

Read Matthew 21:18-22

Q. How can what Jesus did to the fig tree be described as a prophetic action? (See Jeremiah 8:4-9, 13; Hosea 9:10-17 for help).

A: The barren fig tree represents an Israel that has born no fruit of repentance. The time has come for judgment. This is emphasized by the immediate withering of the tree. This action of Jesus prefigures the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple in 70 AD. ... A message for us is God wants obedience & good deeds that spring from a living love for him..."

Mission Co-op Weekend August 10th/11th

Fr. Satheesh Caniton, SdC, a priest of the Servants of Charity, will be preaching, on behalf of the Mission Cooperation Program, at the Masses on the weekend of **August 10th/11th.**

The Servants of Charity, founded by the recently canonized St. Luigi Guanella, are an international congregation whose ministries are with persons with developmental disabilities/mental retardation, the elderly who are poor, and children in difficulty. The Servants of Charity serve at residential programs for persons with developmental disabilities (Don Guanella Village, Divine Providence Village, and St. Edmond's Home) in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Fr. Satheesh will be speaking on behalf of the missions of the Servants of Charity in the India, Philippines and Vietnam in which the Servants of Charity serve orphans, persons with physical handicaps, persons with developmental disabilities, undernourished pre-school children and the elderly who are poor.
