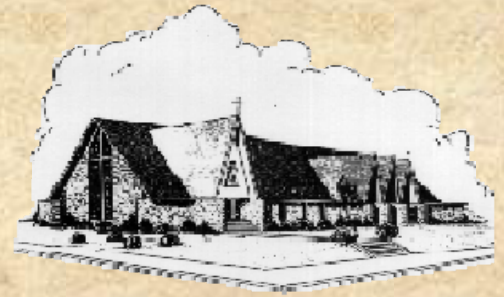

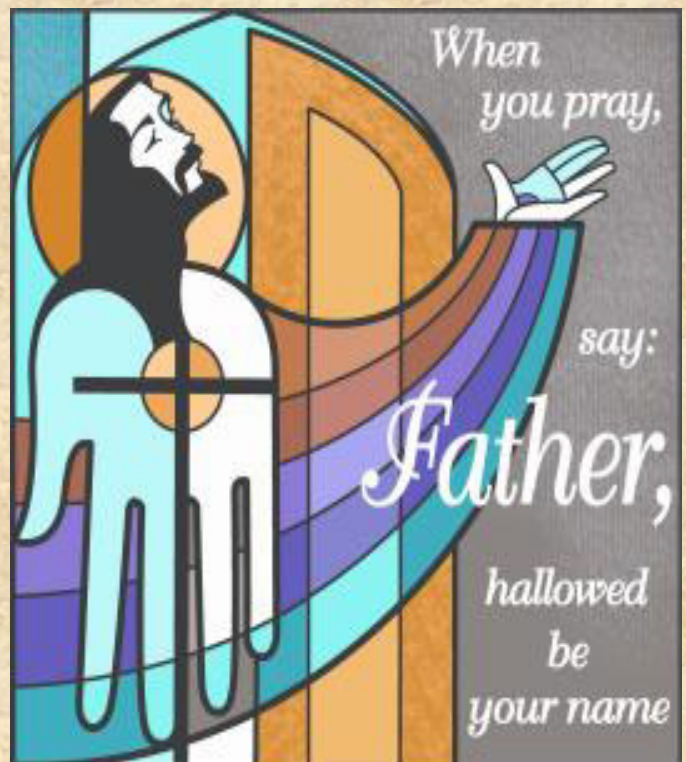
St. John's Hospice Casserole Program

Read Matthew 5:13-16.

Q: This is not the first time the children of Israel have been called the light of the world. What was Israel's God-given mission, & how did Jesus expect his disciples to fulfill it?

A: In the Old Testament, God called Israel to fulfill a mission for him: To be a light to the nations, to open their eyes & bring them out of darkness into the light of his salvation. Now Jesus calls on his disciples to fulfill the same function: To shine through their good works & to live lives that attract others to God. ... By shining the light of God's Word on the paths of life ... we can do for the world what a light does for a dark room."
