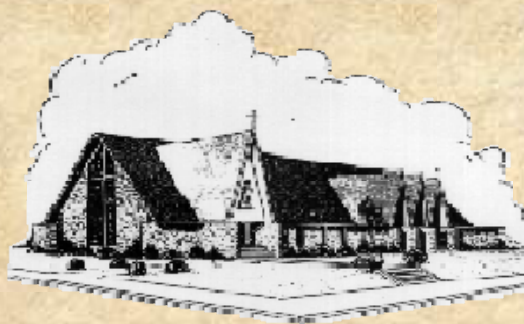

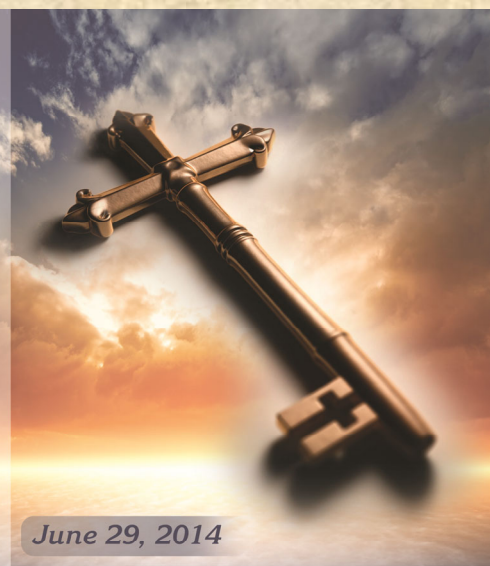
Thank You

Sacraments of Initiation

Adults or school aged children inquiring about the Faith, for the reception of *Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, and for Reception into Full Communion of the Catholic Church*, please call Marianna Rossi .

Baptism of Children is celebrated on Sundays at 1:30 pm. Please call the Parish Office to make necessary arrangements. Interviews prior to the reception of the Sacrament are conducted by Marianna Rossi for first-time parents.

Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation: The *Rite of Reconciliation* is celebrated on Saturdays at 9:30 am and 4:00 pm, and by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage Couples are encouraged to contact the Parish Office soon after their engagement to meet with one of the Parish Priests. It is recommended that a date is set with the Church before a date is set with a reception hall. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires that couples make arrangements for the Wedding no less than six months prior to the planned date of marriage. Either the bride or the groom must be a registered member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish for the Wedding to be scheduled. MASS SCHEDULE REMINDER

In the summer of 2013, Msgr. D'Angelico announced changes to the Mass schedule that went into effect in January 2014. Now that we have had five months of experience with the new schedule and have seen how it has impacted the traffic in the parking lot, a few minor adjustments are necessary.

After consultation with the Parish Pastoral Council, we will enact the following **changes to the Mass schedule effective July 1, 2014:**

- ◆ Mondays through Fridays the morning Mass will be at **9:00 AM**.
- ◆ On Saturdays, the morning Mass will be at **8:00 AM**.
- ◆ Saturday Confessions will be heard at **8:30 AM and 4:00 PM**.
- ◆ On First Fridays during the school year, there will also be a **10:00 AM Mass**.
- ◆ On Holy Days of Obligation, the Mass schedule will be: **7:00 PM Vigil Mass, 6:30 AM, 9:00 AM, 10:30 AM (during the school year), and 12:05 PM**.
