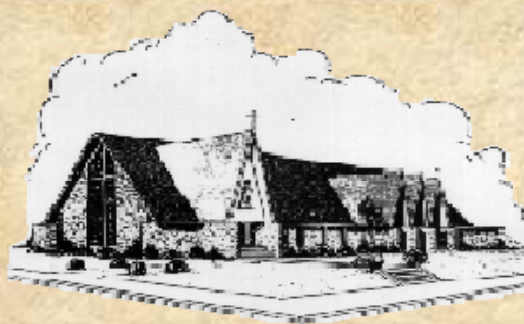

DEO GRATIAS!

My Dear Parishioners,

I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that has been given you in Christ Jesus. (1 Corinthians 1:4). St. Paul addressed those words to the Church in Corinth almost two thousand years ago, but they also express my gratitude for all of you.

God has blessed us in so many ways, and we are called to show our gratitude to Him by our generosity with one another. Many of you have shown remarkable generosity in recent weeks. Our own **OLGC Knights of Columbus council #15658** and its nearly 140 members under the leadership of Grand Knight Kevin Madison have recently celebrated their "Outreach Week" by giving us all excellent examples of generosity. Our sacred liturgies during Holy Week were truly inspiring thanks to all those who participated in them. Our parish **Altar Servers** under the direction of **Kevin Madison** served with outstanding competence, and most importantly, with great reverence. They are the best servers with which I have ever had the privilege to work. Our **parish choir** and all in the parish music ministry under the direction of **Joan Kozlowski** were truly inspiring.

During the extreme winter of 2013 – 2014, many parishioners helped greatly by contributing over \$11,000 in our special collections for snow and ice removal. No one expected such winter weather, but I knew I could count on all of you for your help.

On behalf of Fr. Kilgallon and myself, I thank you all. We both ask Almighty God to bless you and your families during this Easter Season. May the peace of the Risen Christ be with you.

Sacraments of Initiation

Adults or school aged children inquiring about the Faith, for the reception of *Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, and for Reception into Full Communion of the Catholic Church*, please call Marianna Rossi .

Baptism of Children is celebrated on Sundays at 1:30 pm. Please call the Parish Office to make necessary arrangements. Interviews prior to the reception of the Sacrament are conducted by Marianna Rossi for first-time parents.

Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation: The *Rite of Reconciliation* is celebrated on Saturdays at 9:30 am and 4:00 pm, and by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage Couples are encouraged to contact the Parish Office soon after their engagement to meet with one of the Parish Priests. It is recommended that a date is set with the Church before a date is set with a reception hall. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires that couples make arrangements for the Wedding no less than six months prior to the planned date of marriage. Either the bride or the groom must be a registered member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish for the Wedding to be scheduled.
