



Matthew Bible Study

If contemplating whether to join the Bible Study, please keep in mind the following:



- * Matthew is a very short & easy read with which we are familiar.
- * For a deeper understanding of Scripture, we will learn about the connection between the Old & New Testaments - WOW moments!

- * DVD will be shown at the beginning so if your time is limited, you may leave afterwards.
- * If you have time & enjoy small group discussions with fellow parishioners, please stay.
- * The Church for this coming year will be using Matthew as the primary Gospel! (Cycle A).

Read Matthew 28:16-20.

Q: Of what name of Jesus, a name Matthew emphasized in chapter 1, are these words a reminder- 'I am with you always, to the close of age.'?

A: The words harken back (see Isaiah 7:14, 8:8) to Jesus' name Emmanuel, which means 'God with us'. In the Holy Spirit & in his real presence in the Eucharist, God is with us in a far deeper way than he ever had been."

Mission Co-op Weekend August 10th/11th

Fr. Satheesh Caniton, SdC, a priest of the Servants of Charity, will be preaching, on behalf of the Mission Cooperation Program, at the Masses on the weekend of **August 10th/11th**.

The Servants of Charity, founded by the recently canonized St. Luigi Guanella, are an international congregation whose ministries are with persons with developmental disabilities/mental retardation, the elderly who are poor, and children in difficulty.

The Servants of Charity serve at residential programs for persons with developmental disabilities (Don Guanella Village, Divine Providence Village, and St. Edmond's Home) in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

Fr. Satheesh will be speaking on behalf of the missions of the Servants of Charity in the India, Philippines and Vietnam in which the Servants of Charity serve orphans, persons with physical handicaps, persons with developmental disabilities, undernourished preschool children and the elderly who are poor.

A second collection will be taken up at the Masses next weekend, and your generous support of their missionary efforts would be much appreciated.
