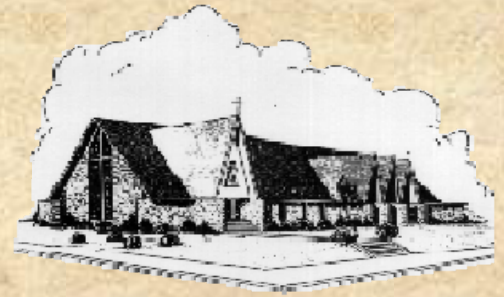

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires that couples make arrangements for the Wedding no less than six months prior to the planned date of marriage. - ♦ or simply want to learn more about the Church, its life, and its teachings,

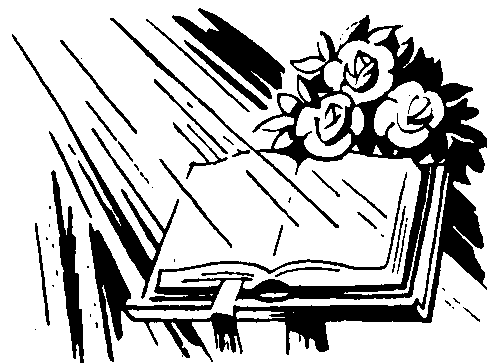
