

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

The RCIA is a parish-sponsored program established to help adults prepare for reception into the Catholic Church, or to learn more about the faith they were baptized into, but never raised in. The RCIA is a series of presentations centering on the truths of the Catholic Faith. The program begins in September. RCIA is open to the following:

- 1 - Persons who were baptized and raised in a non-Catholic Faith, but now wish to embrace the Catholic Faith.
- 2 - Persons who were never baptized into a Christian Faith, but now wish to embrace the Catholic Faith.
- 3 - Persons who were baptized Catholic, but were not instructed in the faith, and have not received the Sacraments of Penance, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- 4 - Persons who were baptized Catholic but who have little knowledge of their Catholic Faith, due to lack of Catholic education (Parochial school or a CCD program) as a young person.
