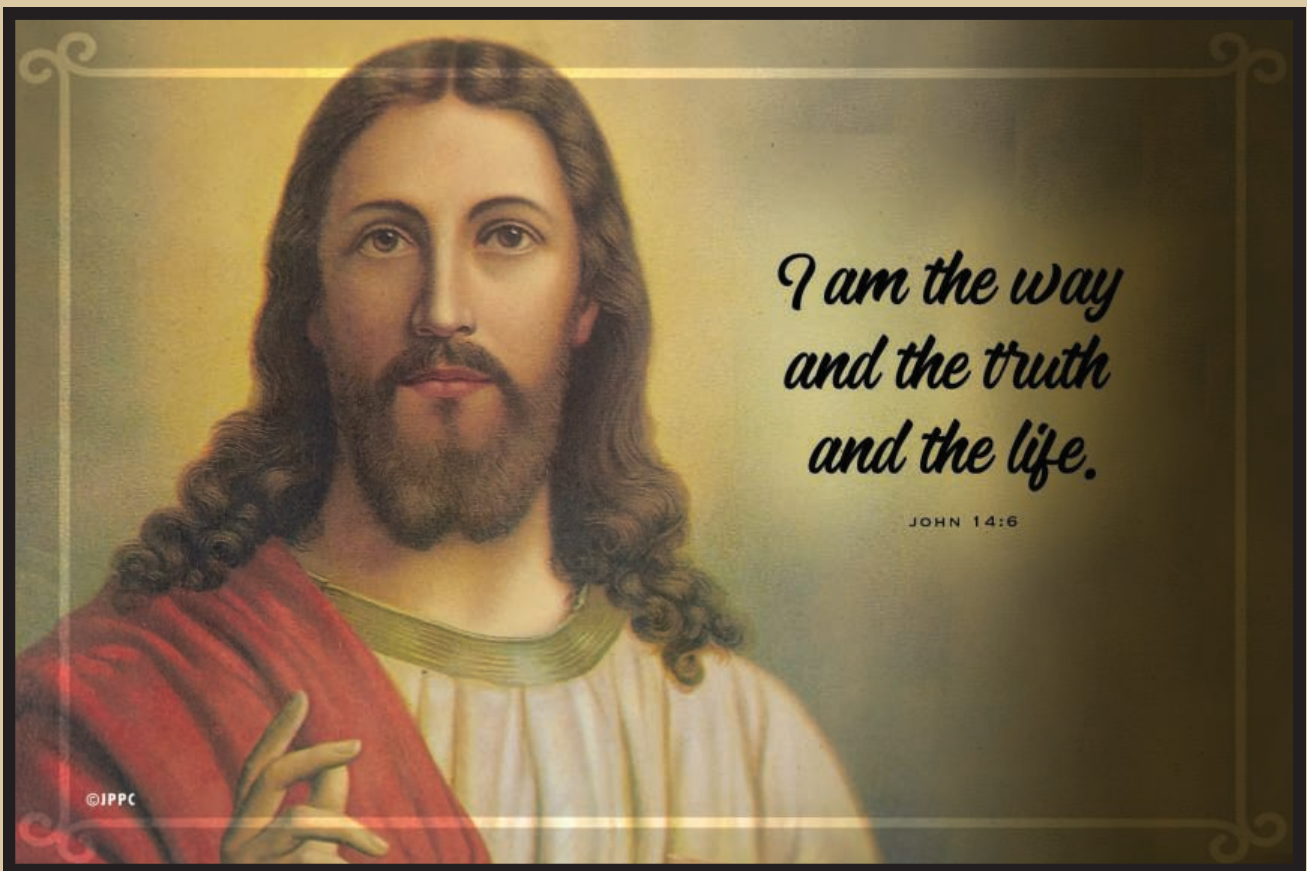

WHAT IS A EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS?

A Eucharist Congress is a gathering of lay people and clergy honoring the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist through Adoration, Mass, presentations/talks, and prayer.

Local, national, and international Eucharistic Congresses occur periodically in the life of the Church. You may remember, in 1976 the Philadelphia Archdiocese hosted the 41st International Eucharistic Congress with over 1,500,000 people in attendance. Both St. Teresa of Calcutta and St. Pope John Paul II attended our 41st Congress. In response to the National Eucharistic Revival (2022-2024) called by the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops, the Philadelphia Archdiocese has planned a local Eucharistic Congress. The Congress will take place on Saturday, September 30, 2023, and will be held on the grounds of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa (Doylestown) with Archbishop Nelson Perez in attendance.

By participating in a Eucharistic Congress, you will be partaking in an historic church event. All are invited to honor the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist!

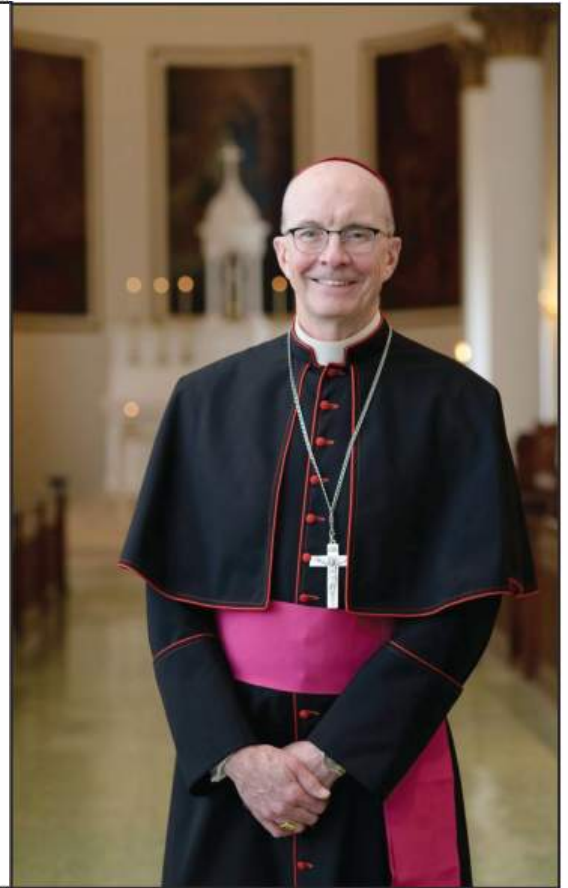

AS THE 12TH BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF HARRISBURG**

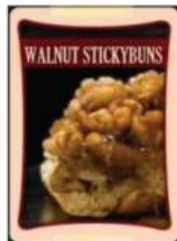
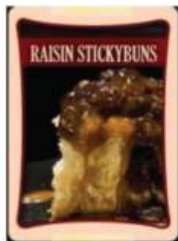
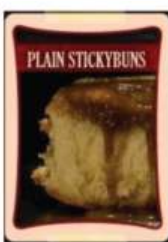
