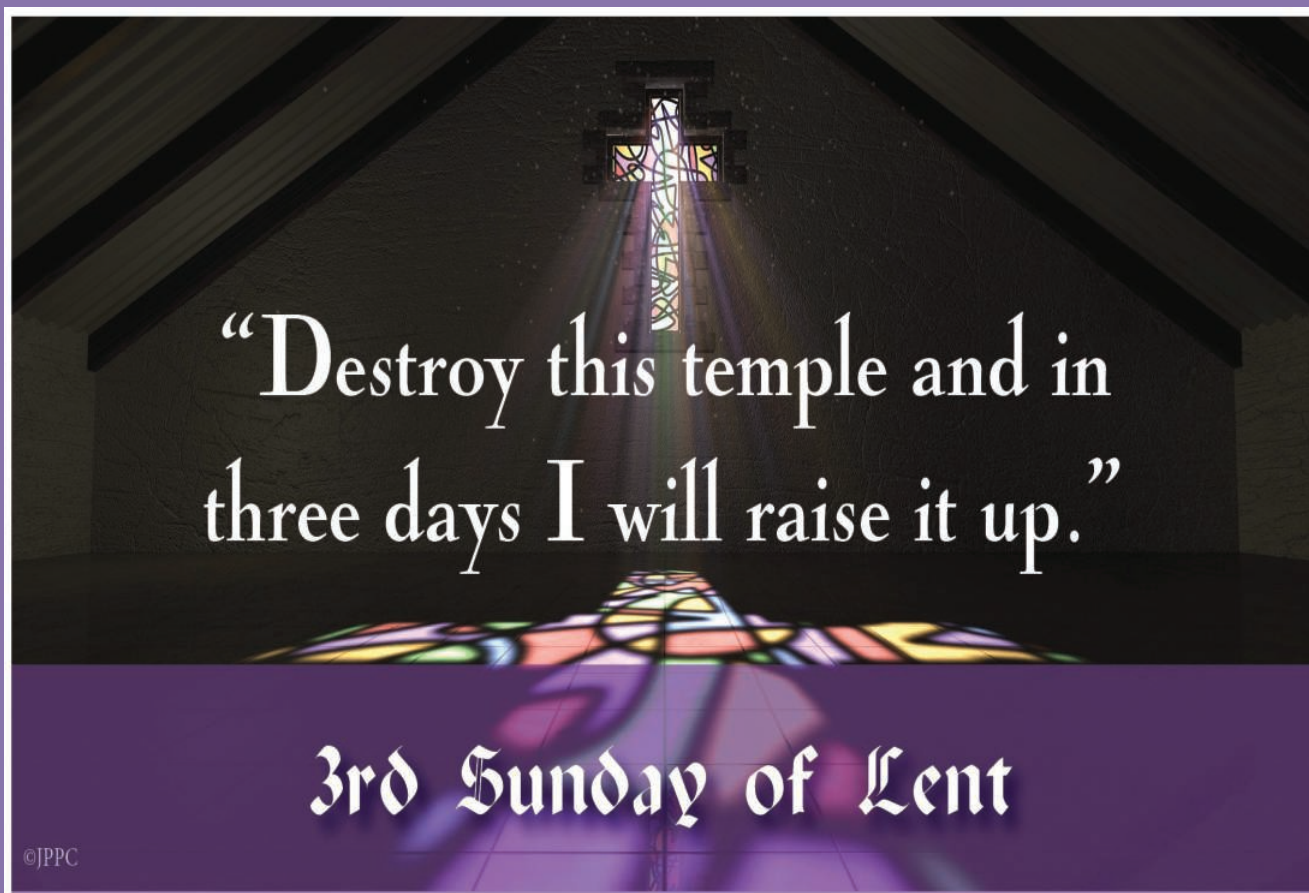

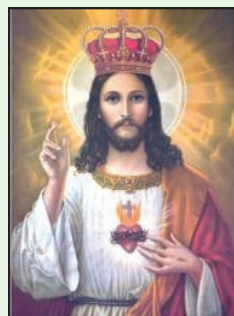

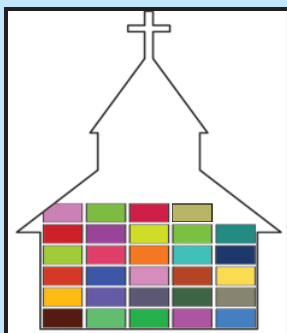
Requested by Our Lady of Fatima:
