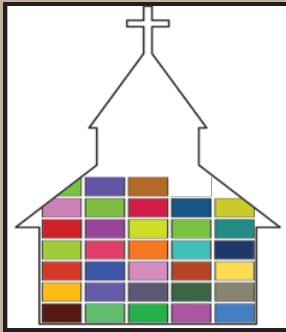
The Sacrament of the Sick is available any time upon request. *Holy Communion for the homebound* is available upon request and is arranged through the parish offices.
