Invitation to the Carlo Acutis Shrine in Malvern, PA - Wednesday, August 20 from 8:30 am to 3 pm

Dear Friends,

The parish DRE, Kristal Alexander, and I are delighted to extend a heartfelt invitation to you, your family, and your friends to join us on a transformative pilgrimage dedicated to learning about the life, faith, and enduring legacy of Carlo Acutis—a remarkable young man on the path to sainthood. On September 7, 2025 he will be declared a saint by Pope Leo XIV. How deeply God can work in a soul open to grace, despite a young age!

This visit seeks not only to honor Carlo Acutis, but also to immerse participants in his remarkable life. We will hear of the spiritual practices that shaped his journey. This is more than a trip—it is an invitation to grow in faith, deepen our understanding of the Eucharist, and encounter the love of God through the inspiring example of a modern disciple.

The day is a chance to:

- Discover how an ordinary life can become extraordinary through trust in God and love of neighbor.

- Participate in Mass and devotions that nourish the heart and uplift the soul.

"The Eucharist is my highway to Heaven."

Our Malvern day trip is open to everyone: young people searching for meaningful role models; families desiring to deepen their faith together; catechists, teachers, and all those who wish to learn more about Carlo Acutis and the Church's invitation to holiness in the modern world.

Our time together will be a blend of spiritual enrichment, cultural immersion, and personal discovery. We will listen to a talk from an expert on Carlo's Exhibit, and reflect on the life of Carlo through Scripture, prayer, and viewing the exhibit of Eucharistic miracles. To make the most of this day, we encourage you to prepare spiritually and practically. Take time to learn about Carlo Acutis beforehand—read his writings, explore the Eucharistic miracles he documented, and pray for the grace to be open to what God wishes to reveal during this journey. Come with an open heart, ready for adventure, service, and surprise.
