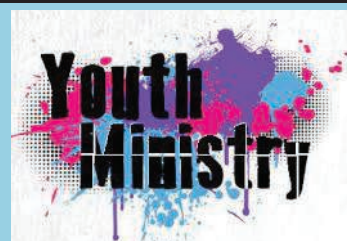

Dear Parishioners,

On Monday, August 25th, OLGC School opened its doors for the start of the 2025-2026 school year. We did so as a newly awarded **Archdiocesan School of Distinction for Growth**. This recognition was based on our students' exceptional academic growth, as measured by year-over-year performance on the Normal Curve Equivalent (NCE) scale. To qualify for this distinction, our school demonstrated that a majority of classes (80%) at each tested grade level showed growth in all content areas. I congratulate our faculty for their dedication to student achievement!

A sincere thank you to our parishioners who continue to contribute to our fundraising efforts. As a direct result of these efforts we were able to complete the following projects over the summer:

- The addition of a new Sensory Support Classroom and Hall space to assist students in the areas of self regulation, reduce anxiety and enhance social skills. This is an integral part of our Learning Support program.
- New flooring was installed in all classrooms on B level for a more modern look and as a result reducing our cleaning costs.
- The first floor brick of the school building was pointed and painted and a new mural was designed on one wall enhancing our welcoming appearance.
- * A new television was installed at the main entrance as an enhancement to our marketing efforts.

We also welcome several new faculty members to our team this year! I am thrilled with the talent and enthusiasm they bring to our team.

Dear God, as our students begin this school year, we pray that Your strength and peace will cover them each and every day. Remind them they can turn to You when they feel scared or discouraged, and You will give them exactly what they need. We humbly ask that You will remind them that they don't have to do this life alone because You are always with them. No matter what obstacles come their way. We pray they will find strength and courage in You alone.
