Principal's Corner

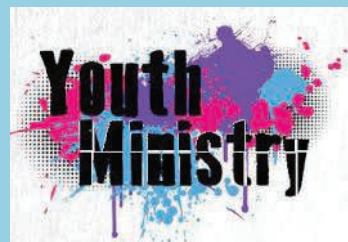
Dear Parishioners,
