Sacrament of Matrimony

Deacon Rich was raised in the Jewish faith. In November, 1981, he married a “cradle” Catholic, and they raised their three children in the Catholic faith.

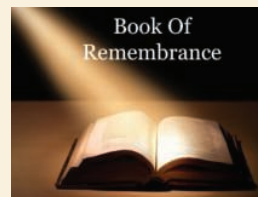
At the Easter Vigil in 1996, Deacon Rich became a fully initiated Roman Catholic.

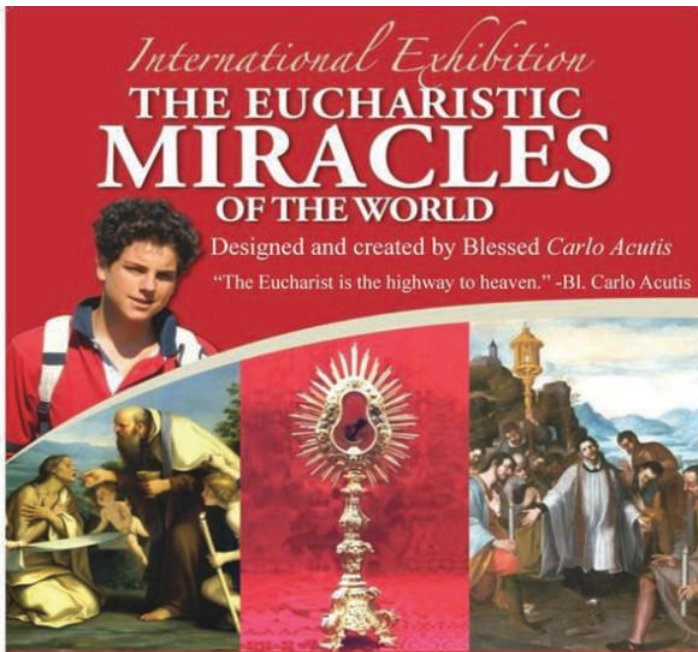


OLGC Wedding Rehearsal Director Needed
