Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to marry *must* contact the parish office to meet with a priest at least six months before the planned wedding date. Couples should meet with the priest *before* setting a date with a reception venue. The bride and/or groom must be a registered member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish. Available wedding times at OLGC are NO LATER than 2:00pm on Saturdays and NO EARLIER than 4:00pm on weekdays during the school year.

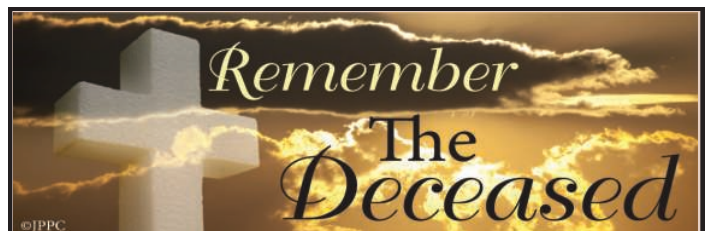

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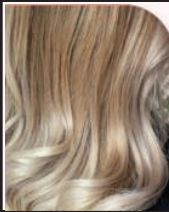


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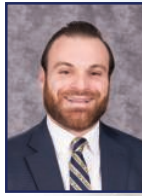
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
