Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples planning to marry *must* contact the parish office to meet with a priest at least six months before the planned wedding date. Couples should meet with the priest *before* setting a date with a reception venue. The bride and/or groom must be a registered member of Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish. Available wedding times at OLGC are NO LATER than 2:00pm on Saturdays and NO EARLIER than 4:00pm on weekdays during the school year.

OLGC Scrip Program 'Tis the season to earn

Earn on all your holiday shopping and gifting when you buy gift cards or shop online through OLGC RaiseRight program!

The money you're already planning to spend on things like gifts, wrapping paper, stocking stuffers, groceries, travel, and more, can help you earn toward your child's or grandchild's grade school, high school, college tuition or contribution to their PA529 account. It adds up fast! Here's how to earn:

1. **Buy gift cards** from RaiseRight and use them to pay for all your holiday expenses. Every gift card purchase from RaiseRight earns up to 20% back!
2. **Shop online** through RaiseRight—log into your RaiseRight account, click through to shop directly on a brand's website, and earn upon completing a purchase. Please note that online orders must be paid at time of order placement in the form of a credit card, debit card and link to your bank account. There are fees which apply unless you place your order in the Scrip office paying with cash or checks. Orders placed before noon on Tuesday usually come in on Thursday afternoons.
3. **Dine locally**—link a credit or debit card in your RaiseRight account to earn 5% every time you dine at thousands of restaurants nationwide and pay with your linked card.

Plus, you can **earn extra by combining earnings!** Shop online through RaiseRight, then buy a gift card to use as payment for your online purchase. You'll earn both ways at once!
