A SPIRITUAL GIFT FOR CHRISTMAS: AN ADVENT SCRIPTURAL ROSARY

Ever since the Magi visited Jesus, Christians have expressed their love for one another and their gratitude to God by giving gifts at Christmas. We often struggle to decide what gifts to give and find ourselves shopping for hours in stores and online for material things to give. Consider giving a gift of immeasurable value that will cost you no money. Prayer costs only our time and our devotion. Moreover, we can give the gift of prayer to those who are no longer physically present to us. Our loved ones who have died do not need something from a store. They can benefit greatly from our prayers. After the Mass and the Divine Office, the Rosary is a very powerful prayer. A "Scriptural Rosary" is a recitation of the Rosary in which there are brief readings from the Bible to facilitate meditation on the Mysteries of the Rosary. I invite you to join me for a special time of devotion in which we will gather in the Presence of Our Lord, pray a Scriptural Rosary, have some time for silent prayer, and conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament on **Monday, December 15 at 7:00 PM**. According to St. Alphonsus Ligouri, Christmas is a time when many souls are released from Purgatory. Please try to take advantage of this Advent opportunity to give an important spiritual gift to someone you love (living or dead). By the mercy of God and the intercession of Our Blessed Mother, our gift may help them greatly in ways that matter the most.

the coming of the Lord."*

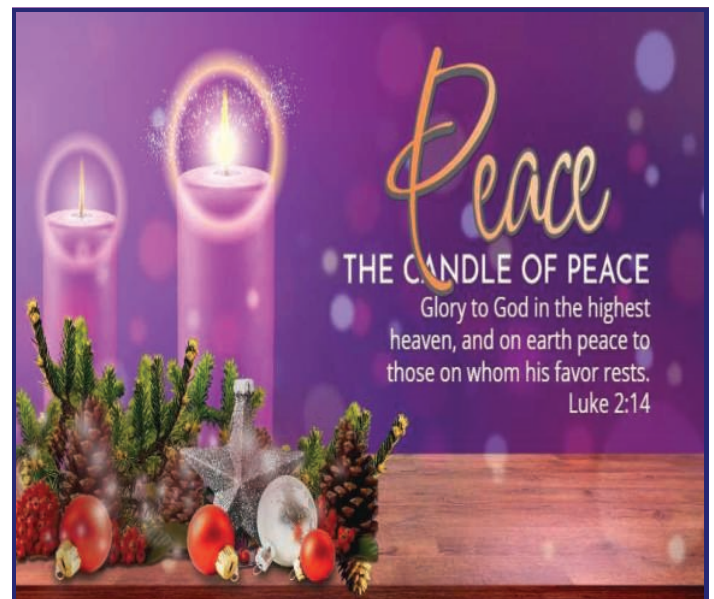
