Along with active participation in Mass and daily recitation of the Rosary, one popular Lenten devotion is the Way of the Cross (or “Stations of the Cross”). Our parish will commence praying the Stations next Friday, continuing each Friday in Lent.

Participating in the Way of the Cross is an opportunity for Catholics to recall and meditate on Jesus’ last hours on earth, his Passion, and all that led to his crucifixion and death on Calvary. Through the use of pictures, images, statues (often affixed to the walls of a church), and with the help of pointed prayers and meditations for each station, we become more aware of Christ’s love for us. “Greater love has no one than this: that he lay down his life for his friends” (Jn 15:13). The Stations of the Cross strongly remind us of Our Lord’s ultimate expression of love.

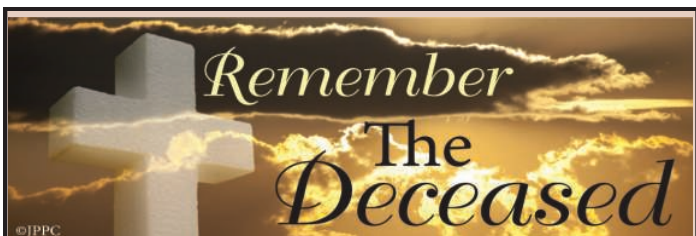

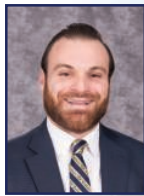
