Lenten question of the Season
*I count more than 40 days of lent.
How come the Church says
it lasts 40 days?*

This is a common inquiry that priests and religious educators are asked each year. Someone, in some place, gets out their calendar and counts the days that they think comprise the lenten season. Here’s how it works:

From Ash Wednesday to the 1st Sunday of Lent – 4 days

From 1st Sunday of Lent to Palm Sunday – 30 days

From Palm Sunday to Holy Thursday – 3 days

Triduum-3 days leading up to the Easter Vigil
& the Easter celebration

TOTAL DAYS OF LENT = 40

Note well: Sundays are technically NOT part of the count because the Church, from its earliest days, celebrated the **Resurrection of Jesus** on Sundays. Sundays were the Lord’s Day, a day of joy feting our emancipation from sin, and the prospect of life eternal with Jesus. Also the Triduum (Holy Thursday through Holy Saturday), while a separate liturgical season for ritual purposes, was still considered to be a time of fasting and vigilance in anticipation of the Lord’s resurrection. Put those calendars away and be ready to explain to all who dispute the number of days in Lent. The answer every year is 40!

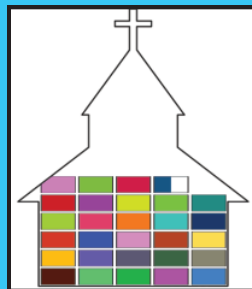

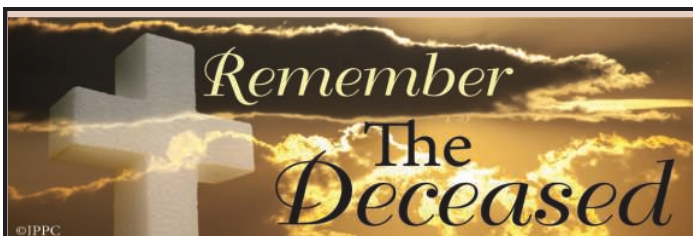

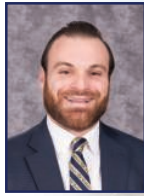
