Sacrament of Matrimony

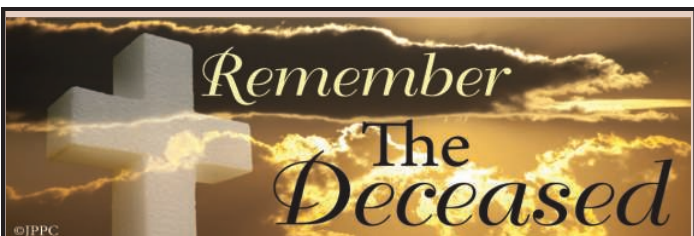

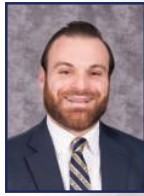
