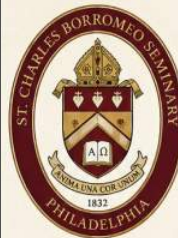

Our tour will be led by **Deacon Chuck Lewis**, Assistant to the Rector for External Affairs & Alumni Relations and adjunct professor.

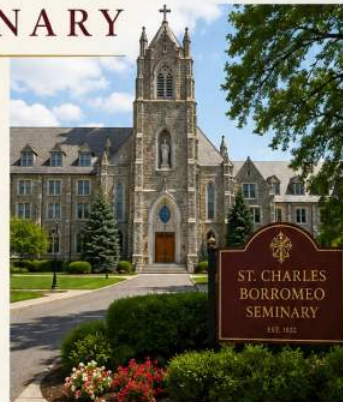

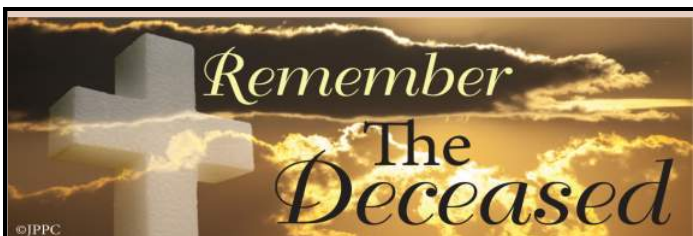

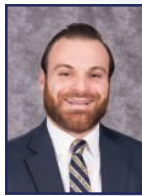
