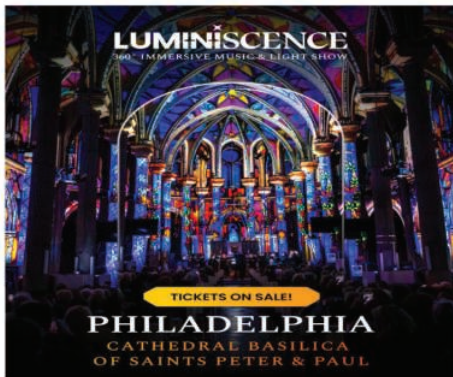
Luminiscence at The Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul

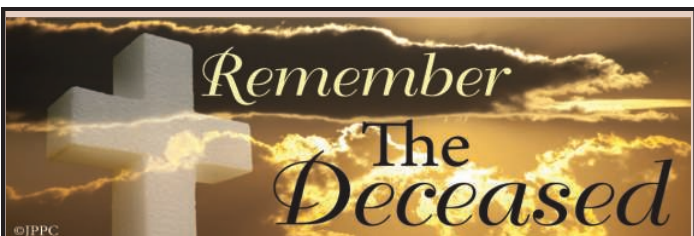

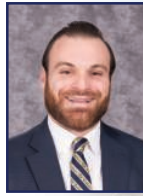
